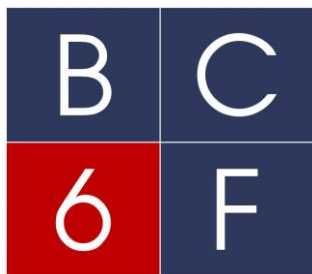
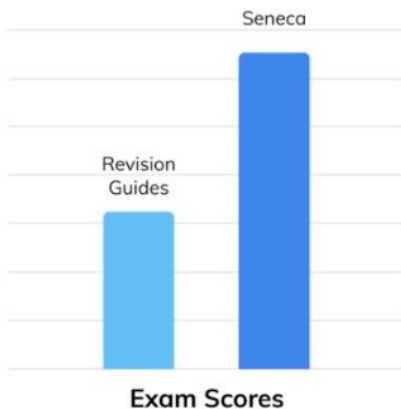


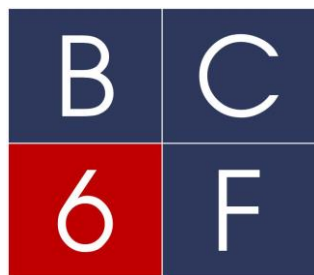
Students in **Years 7-13** should use Seneca to help support the retrieval of the knowledge required for each subject.

You can filter by date to see how things are changing over time and **can even add multiple children** if you like.



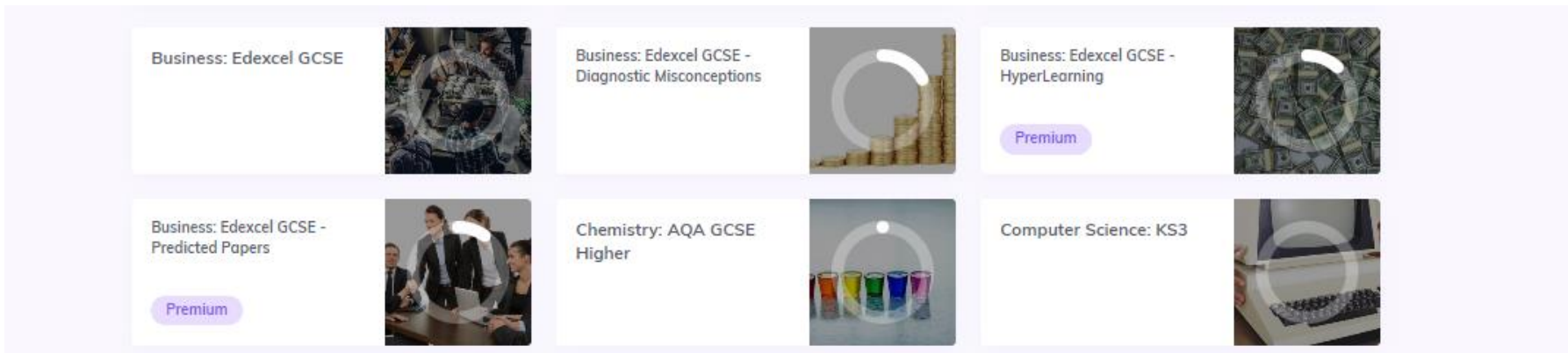

How often should my child use Seneca?

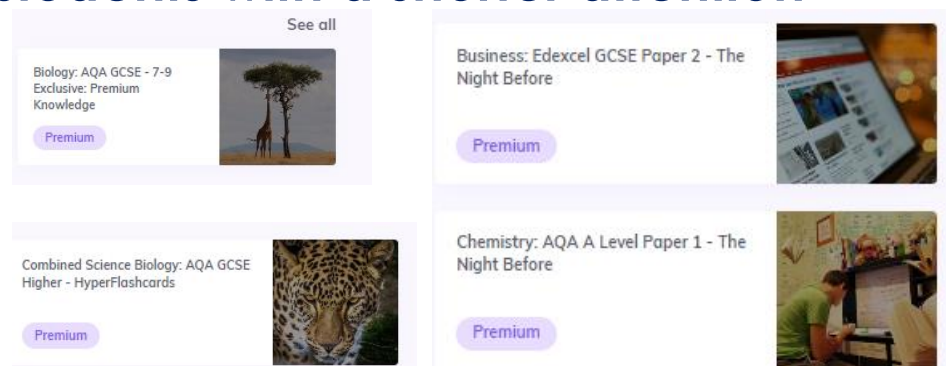


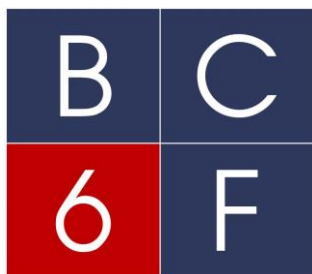
- **Repeating topics over a long period of time improves memory & understanding**, so we recommend using Seneca as much as possible throughout the year.
- **In the run up to important exams, like GCSEs, students should use Seneca more often**, perhaps every day. **During term time, we recommend at least 30 minutes a week** or whenever they want to learn or practice something new is also a good idea

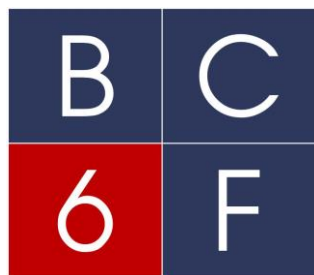


- Seneca will work on any device you want to use it on.

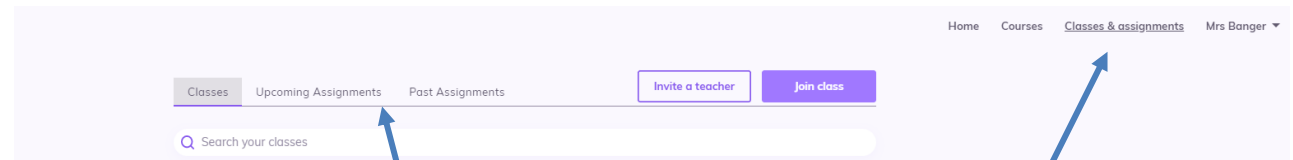
Help your child to log into their Seneca account at home.

- 3) Your child can use the sign in with Microsoft or can enter their school email and password.

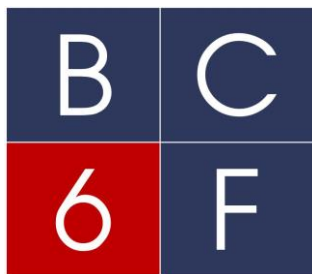


Step 2

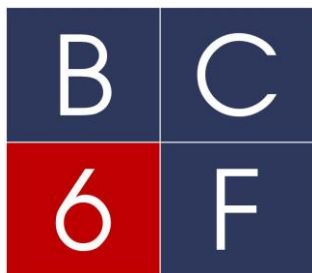
- Tell your child to click onto the assignment and then start to complete the sections that the teacher has assigned.

- Then they can start to answer the questions.

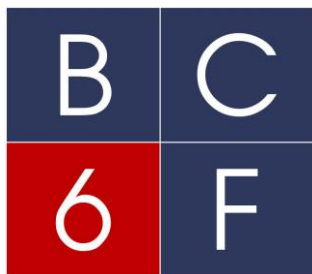


Step 3

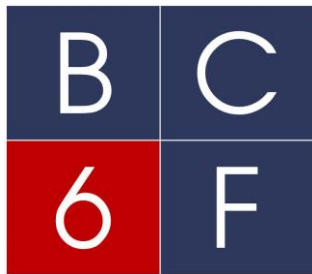
Your child can click into any section in the list and complete the activities.

The smart algorithm will make suggestions about what to revise.

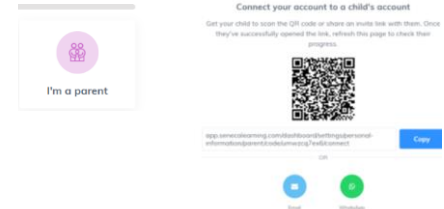


Step 4

- You are now connected.





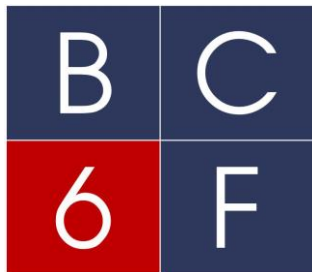

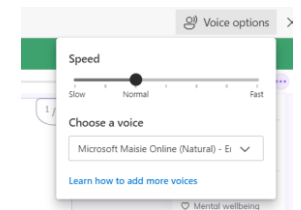
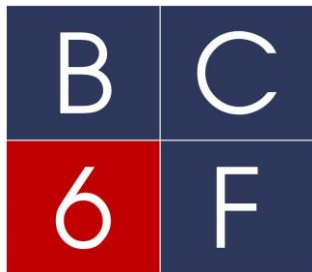
Read out loud
