Following the UK moving to the “delay” stage in relation to the coronavirus outbreak, it is our school policy that students, staff, parents and members of the community should not come to the school site if they have flu or cold symptoms, in particular:

- a high temperature
- a new continuous cough

It is essential that parents notify school as soon as possible if their child is absent from school and the reason for the absence.

Government advice is that anyone displaying these symptoms should remain at home for 7 days.

This will help to protect others in your community while you are infectious.

Do not go to a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital.

You do not need to contact NHS 111 to tell them you’re staying at home.

There will not be testing people who are self-isolating with mild symptoms.
