- Walesby Camp

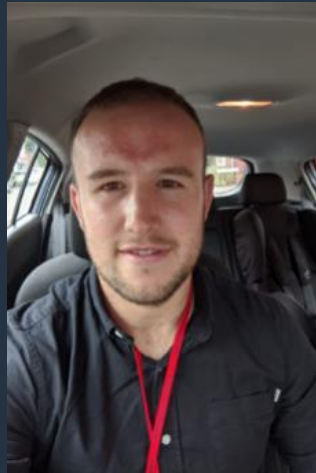


# Bramcote College – we learn differently!

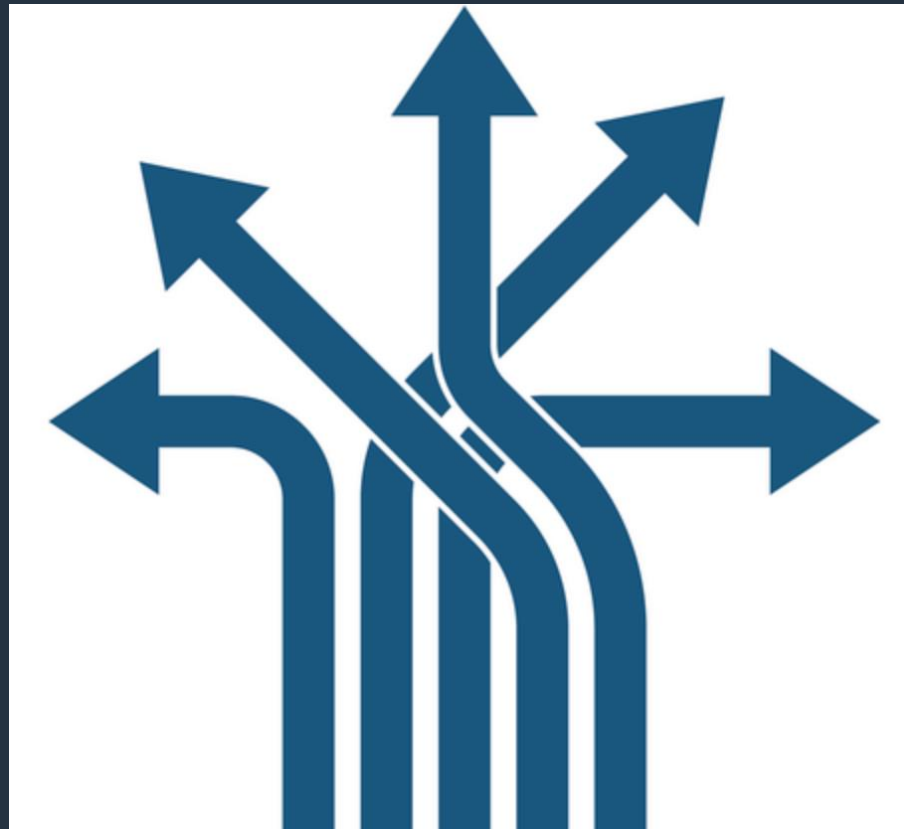

# How to apply

- If you live at a **Nottinghamshire County** address, you can apply online at:

- You will require an email address to register online and can use the personal unique identification number (UID) for your child, which is on the information sent to you by School Admissions to your home address.

Or

- You can apply by completing an application form.
- The Admissions team contact number is **0300 500 8080** to request an application form or to apply over the telephone.

The national **closing date** for applications is Saturday **October 31<sup>st</sup> 2022** place **offers** will be sent out by your local council on Monday **March 1<sup>st</sup> 2023** either by email or by post depending on how you apply
