Objectives/purpose	<p>To gain a GCSE in Art and Design – Fine Art</p> <p>To continue to develop and build on skills from KS3.</p> <p>Further develop skills in drawing and painting.</p> <p>Learn how to effectively use a wide range of materials and techniques.</p> <p>Learn about a wide range of artists and art movements.</p> <p>Develop skills in analysing art work.</p> <p>Build on skills in assessing and annotating their work.</p> <p>Understand the requirements of each assessment objective.</p>
Autumn Term	<p><u>Still Life – Guidelines and Proportion.</u></p> <p>To build up and develop work for Component 1 – coursework portfolio.</p> <p>Drawing from primary and secondary sources.</p> <p>Research into the artist Paul Cezanne and other Still Life artists.</p> <p>In-depth analyse of artist's work.</p> <p>Continue to develop and improve observational drawing skills.</p> <p>Learn about proportion and how to draw accurately by using guidelines.</p> <p>Develop more sophisticated shading and tonal effects and techniques.</p>
Spring Term	<p><u>Still Life – Artist copies and extend use of materials.</u></p> <p>Learn how to use a wide range of materials and techniques. Chalk, charcoal, oil pastel, acrylic paint.</p> <p>Build on knowledge and skills in using pencil crayons, pen, watercolour pencils and paint.</p> <p>Create a final Still Life painting.</p>
Summer Term	<p><u>Portrait.</u></p> <p>Build on and develop skills from year 9 in drawing portraits and using a grid.</p> <p>Research into the artist Iain MacArthur and analyse his work.</p> <p>Create a portrait inspired by the artist they have researched.</p>
How is progress measured?	<p>The work is teacher assessed – using AQA exam board criteria.</p> <p>Regular feedback is given on individual pieces of work.</p> <p>End of project assessment</p>
How is the subject externally examined? (KS4 and KS5)	<p>There is a mock exam in the Summer Term.</p> <p>There is no external assessment in year 10.</p> <p>Component 1 portfolio: worth 60% of the final mark</p> <p>Component 2 portfolio: worth 40% of the final mark.</p>
Extending Learning at home	<p>Homework is provided in lessons and on Go4 schools and based on the topic being covered in school.</p> <p>Homework tasks consist of either a research task or a practical task to practise and develop skills learnt in lessons.</p> <p>Students are given an effort grade and a target to improve.</p>
Support Available	<p>Differentiated resources are available for students to use in lessons.</p> <p>Sketchbooks and portfolios are provided.</p> <p>Specialist materials provided.</p>
