Year Group: 7

Subject: ART

Objectives/purpose	To establish extent of skills on KS3 entry and assess baseline level. Develop basic skills in drawing and painting. Learn about colour theory and how to mix colours. Understand context and how Art links with other subjects. Learn how to analyse art work. Learn how to assess their own and others work.
Autumn Term	<u>Baseline Assessment – Shoe project.</u> Drawing from primary and secondary sources. Research into different designs. Designing a fantasy shoe or trainer.
Spring Term	<u>Drawing and painting skills. Colour theory.</u> Learn about pencil grades and how to create tone. Developing shading skills. Developing skills using pencil crayons. Colour theory and basic painting skills and colour mixing.
Summer Term	<u>Mythological Creatures and Dragons.</u> Research into mythological creatures. Learn about cultural differences of dragons and the myths surrounding them. Analysing St George and the Dragon paintings. Developing drawing skills. Mark making techniques using pen. Building on shading techniques learnt in Spring term and applying this to their drawing. Developing painting techniques and using watercolour paints
How is progress measured?	The Baseline project is teacher assessed – using EDSM criteria. Termly teacher assessment using EDSM criteria.
Extending Learning at home	Homework is provided in lessons and on Go4 schools and based on the topic being covered in school. Homework tasks consist of either a piece of research or a practical task to practise and develop skills learnt in lessons. Students are given an effort grade and a target to improve.
Support Available	Differentiated resources are available for students to use in lessons. Sketchbooks are given to each student to use in school. Homework folders are provided and materials can be borrowed to use at home.
