Objectives/purpose	<p>To continue to develop and build on skills from year 7 and 8.</p> <p>Develop skills in drawing and painting.</p> <p>Develop knowledge of proportion, portraits and perspective.</p> <p>Understand context and how Art and design link with other subjects and cultures.</p> <p>Develop skills in analysing art work.</p> <p>Build on skills in assessing their own and others work.</p>
Autumn Term	<p><u>Portrait – Guidelines and Proportion.</u></p> <p>Drawing from primary and secondary sources.</p> <p>Research into the artist Stanley Spencer. Analyse his work.</p> <p>Continue to develop and improve observational drawing skills.</p> <p>Learn about proportion and how to draw accurately by using guidelines</p>
Spring Term	<p><u>Portrait – Grid technique and Pop Art.</u></p> <p>Learn how to use a grid to draw an image accurately.</p> <p>Research into the artist Roy Lichtenstein and analyse his work.</p> <p>Learn about Pop Art. Apply this technique and style to their work.</p> <p>Build up drawing, colouring and painting skills.</p>
Summer Term	<p><u>Perspective.</u></p> <p>Learn how to do one point and two point perspective.</p> <p>Research into art work that use perspective techniques.</p> <p>Apply the skills learnt in previous lessons to their work</p> <p>Create a final design including portrait, Pop Art and perspective.</p>
How is progress measured?	<p>The work is teacher assessed – using EDSM criteria.</p> <p>Termly teacher assessment – using EDSM criteria</p>
Extending Learning at home	<p>Homework is provided in lessons and on Go4 schools and based on the topic being covered in school.</p> <p>Homework tasks consist of either a research task or a practical task to practise and develop skills learnt in lessons.</p> <p>Students are given an effort grade and a target to improve.</p>
Support Available	<p>Differentiated resources are available for students to use in lessons.</p> <p>Sketchbooks are given to each student to use in school.</p> <p>Homework folders are provided and materials can be borrowed to use at home.</p>
