To gain an A level qualification in English Literature To explore a relevant, engaging and an up-to-date study of literature. We encourage students to be independent and critical learners in their study of a range of texts. Students will be equipped to make interpretations of texts within their social and historical contexts, whilst also making connections of how love is presented through the ages.

Students will be able to watch the film versions to consider alternative interpretations of these texts by certain directors and producers.

Introduction to NEA (Non Exam Assessment) Independent critical study: texts across time. Angela Carter's The Bloody Chamber Collection of Stories coupled with: An independent choice of text by students to compare with the above in a written essay with a chosen title and area of focus.
Regular Teacher Assessments at the end of every half term at least. Progress Checks at various timetabled points of the year. Mock Exams at scheduled points in the year.
Paper 1: Love through the ages. Study of three texts. Examination will include two unseen poems Assessed. Written exam: 3 hours. 40% of A-level. Paper 2: Texts in shared contexts. Study of three texts: one prose, one poetry, and one drama. Examination will include an unseen prose extract. Written exam: 2 hours 30 minutes - open book 40% of A-level. Non-exam assessment: Independent critical study: texts across time Comparative critical study of two texts, at least one of which must have been written pre-1900. One extended essay (2500 words) and a bibliography. 20% of A-level. Assessed by teachers. Moderated by AQA.
Homework tasks set regularly to extend classroom study or to conduct independent reading of scholarly articles and critics' views and feedback in class.
