Summer Term	<p><b>Component 2 Exam Portfolio</b></p> <p>Continue developing and experimenting with own response to selected exam title. 10 hour 'sustained focus' period completed early in May</p>
How is progress measured?	<p><b>Mock exam</b></p> <p>Component 1 portfolio final piece and evaluation is completed as a mock exam</p> <p>Ongoing and regular feedback and monitoring of understanding through individual tutoring and mentoring in lessons</p>
How is the subject externally examined? (KS4 and KS5)	<p><b>Component 1 portfolio:</b> worth 60% of the final mark <b>Component 2 portfolio:</b> worth 40% of the final mark. (Component 2 portfolio final piece must be completed during a 10 hour period of 'sustained focus')</p>
Extending Learning at home	<p>Own photoshoots research into different photographers Experimentation with different methods of editing (digital and practical)</p>
