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Assessment

Component I

A portfolio that in total shows coverage of the four assessment objectives. It must include a sustained project evidencing the journey from initial engagement to the realisation of intentions and a selection of further work undertaken during the student's course of study.

How it's assessed

No time limit 96 marks 60% of GCSE

Component 2

Students respond to their chosen starting point from an externally set assignment paper relating to their subject title, evidencing coverage of all four assessment objectives.

How it's assessed

Preparatory period followed by IO hours of supervised time 96 marks 40% of GCSE







Mixed Media

Use of a range of media to create exciting textiles.

Drawing

A compulsory part of the course, however this can be achieved through hand, graphics and sewn techniques.

Painting using a range of media, including transfer of images to fabric.

Year IO

Students begin by exploring a range of media and completing workshops to give them the skills to complete the course.

Students will then begin an extended project for their portfolio. This includes producing a sketchbook of research, design development and written annotation. Year II

Students complete their portfolio projects by December.

Students select from a range of starting points and have 3 months to prepare for their 10 hour practical examination.
