Bramcote College Summer School August 2021 – financial report

Bramcote College held our Summer School for 5 days on site during the last week of August. We invited students from our existing Year 7 cohort, as well as those in Year 6 who were about to start with us. In total, over 100 students attended for at least 1 day.

Staffing was made up of our own teachers and teaching assistants, as well as activities provided by external organisations.

Students were given the opportunity to explore a range of school subject areas to boost their skills and engagement, including Art, PE, English, Maths, Music & Drama and Food Technology as well as taking part in team building and personal development challenges.

We brought in external providers to run workshops including drumming, storytelling and outdoor activities (archery, climbing, rifles and orienteering) as well as professional sports coaches to support our PE staff. We also ran a trip to a local country park to support teambuilding and help develop friendships.

Our total costs were £13,180 which included all staffing, resources, food & drinks for students, transport for the trip and externally-provided workshops.
