Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find attached a reminder regarding school uniform and essential/compulsory school equipment.

Having the right equipment in lessons enables pupils to learn and being organised and prepared for school is important. We understand that for different reasons, pupils may find themselves without an essential piece of equipment and we'd ask that they approach Student Support BEFORE registration, where they will be loaned equipment without a correction. We cannot loan calculators and earphones and so would ask that pupils keep these on them at all times - either in bags or zipped inside blazers. Tutors and teachers carry out regular equipment checks, and pupils will be issued with corrections in line with our behaviour policy.

I'd like to also remind parents and carers that mobile phones should not be seen/heard in school. They should be switched off and carried in bags or inside their blazers zipped up. If you need to contact your child during the school day, please do so via reception/student support. If your child is unwell and needs to contact you, they should go to student support and not contact you on their mobile phones.

Students should have a warm and waterproof coat to wear outside

Hoodies are NOT permitted under blazers or as coats

Blazer and school tie



Plain white, long or short sleeved **shirt** that buttons up to the collar

Knee length straight or pleated **skirt**
NO tight tube skirts



Plain black flat **shoes** with black or white socks (not over the knee) or thick black tights with skirts



'Regular' fit, not skinny fit **trousers** and NO leggings or jeans



Black joggers or a black sweatshirt can be worn ONLY if the logo is smaller than a bank card

The PE kit (tops + jogging bottoms, OR shorts, OR leggings) have been updated in 2019. If you purchase any new items, they will be these new designs. Leggings are unchanged.

Getting School Uniform Right

- **School blazer** to be worn travelling to and from school and when moving around the school site, blazers may be taken off in lessons and when given permission on exceptionally hot days not to wear them at all.
- School tie.
- Optional black jumper or cardigan **with school logo** to be worn underneath blazers (NOT instead of blazers).
- Plain, black school trousers, which are tailored but **not** skinny fit or 'short weekends', or a **knee length** tailored skirt which can be straight or pleated (not overly tight and no tube skirts).
- Plain, white shirt which buttons up to the collar. To be worn tucked in, at all times.
- Plain, black, sensible (low heeled) **shoes**.
- Trainers may only be worn during PE lessons. Some pupils have medical exemption which is approved by Heads of Year.
- Plain black or white socks, or plain black tights with a skirt. No over the knee socks with skirts.
- Coats should be warm and waterproof with no large logos/writing. These must be taken off in lessons.
- Headscarves should be in line with school colours.
- No hoodies or sports tops/jackets.
- No caps or hats of any kind can be worn in the building. Students must put coat hoods down when in school.
- Plain black belts can be worn to hold up trousers.

- A suitable school bag: a backpack, messenger bag, or satchel which is large enough to carry books and equipment for the day. No handbags.
- No extremes of dress e.g. extreme hair styles / unnatural hair colours, overly tight shirts or trousers, or overly short skirts.
- **No** make-up. Only clear nail varnish may be worn. False nail/acrylic nails are not **permitted even on non-uniform days**.
- **No** jewellery except for **one** small plain gold/silver ear- stud or small sleeper **in each ear lobe** and a watch. **No nose studs or facial piercings** under any circumstances.
- Tattoos for under 18s are illegal (Tattooing Minors Act 1969)

Getting PE Kit Right

Compulsory Items:

- WHP short sleeve training T-shirt or plain black T-shirt
- WHP ¼ zip micro fleece
- WHP shorts & football socks **or** WHP tracksuit bottoms **or** WHP Leggings
- Trainers

Optional Items:

- Gum shield
- Shin pads
- Football Boots

NO jewellery of any kind can be worn during PE for health & safety reasons

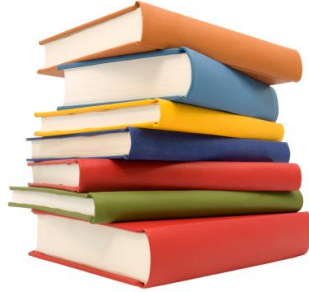

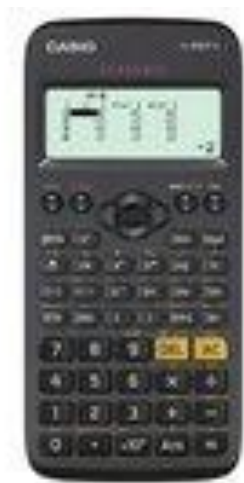
