



Dear Parents and Carers,

As this school year draws to a close, I wanted to share with you an overview of the activities we have in place for the final three days of term. **Students are not expected to wear school uniform next week**, however we do ask them to wear suitable non-uniform clothing which allow them to be comfortable during the planned activities.

Monday 25th July – all events start with students being registered as usual at 8:50am in their form groups.

Year 7: The Wollaton Park trip* will be leaving school at 9:15am and returning to school around 3:00pm. Students will be walking there and back and so will need to wear comfortable shoes. Students will also require a packed lunch (Mrs Crouch has made packed lunches available for any FSM students) and may wish to bring some money to buy an ice cream or drink at the park.

Year 8 & 9: Cinema trip*, leaving school at 9:30am and returning at 1:30pm, with lunch and afternoon activities planned in school. The cinema has contacted us to say that due to staffing shortages, snacks will not be on sale from the cinema, so students are able to bring their own drinks and snacks to have in the cinema.

Year 10: 'Funday' Monday activities in school.

Tuesday 26th July – Year 7, 8 and 9 events will start with students being registered as usual at 8:50am in their form groups.

Year 7: Cinema trip*, leaving school at 9:30am and returning at 12:30pm, with lunch and afternoon activities planned in school. The cinema has contacted us to say that due to staffing shortages, snacks will not be on sale from the cinema, so students are able to bring their own drinks and snacks to have in the cinema.

Year 8 & 9: 'Funday' Tuesday; as a special treat this will include Skate Base coming into school to provide hour long roller disco sessions which includes the loan of skates (so no need to bring your own). Students will need to bring just £1 if they would like to skate for an hour in their timetabled slot. This amazing price is made possible by the support of our fabulous PTA who are subsidising the event to say well done for the year's work.

First aiders will be present and Skate Base have public liability insurance and are fully DBS checked and. Bramcote staff, will be supporting the event too, however, please contact the school to let us know if your child should NOT skate.

Ice lollies will be on sale for 50p.

Year 10: Students are asked to come in and register at 9:10 in the dining hall to go on the cinema and bowling trip*. We will be leaving school at 9:30am and returning by 3:20pm. Students will need a packed lunch (FSM packed lunches have been arranged by Mrs Crouch).

*Letters have been given to students for all off site activities. Those students that are not attending the trips will be taking part with the in school activities.

Wednesday 27th July – a variety of tutor group-based activities with the school day ending at 12:30pm. Weather permitting, we may try to go ahead with a reduced timetable of sport's day events in the morning. This will be reviewed next week.

We look forward to seeing students back in school for the start of the new school year on Thursday September 1st, with all students in school in time for registration (Year 7s at 8:45am and Years 8 to 11 at 8:50am).
