Dear Parent/Carer,

As a school we are looking to re-establish and introduce both pre-covid and brand-new enrichment opportunities for our students. Please see a proposed outline below of the trips we are looking to start up and the approximate costs, which would include travel etc. We are planning this now to give families sufficient time to plan and also to put in place a realistic payment plan that should make most of these trips accessible to all. Understandably, since such trips were last ran, costs have increased significantly. Again, this is why we are trying to create as much lead time as possible to make this affordable. Please note this list is not a full proposal of all trips as there will also be a number of educational trips available throughout the year.

Importantly, please note the current year groups that these will be available to, for example, the year 8 trip is planned for next year so is available to current year 7, not the current year 8.
