Transition

Wednesday 5 July is the second day of Year 6 into 7 transition. We have modified the day to accommodate the transition day; parents of new intake Year 7 will have been contacted.

Years 7 & 8

If your child is currently in Year 7 or 8, there will be no on-site teaching/provision. If their teacher is not striking, work will be set on Microsoft Teams for them to access. If their teacher is striking, there will be no specific work set, but children can access Seneca or Century Learning.

Parents/carers of children in Year 7 & 8 who have been identified as needing an in-school place, will be contacted by phone later this week.
